


5. Configure timestamp format

From v1.6.0 you may change the default timeformat of **MM.DD.YYYY HH.mm.ss** to a format matching your local timestamp format.

The format string is from the [moment.js](#) library.

Just change the format string to one that work in your locale and restart App.

Easy Logger will try to read and use the old format, but you **should** change it to the right one, for the example above, the format will be **dd.MM.yyyy HH.mm.ss**
